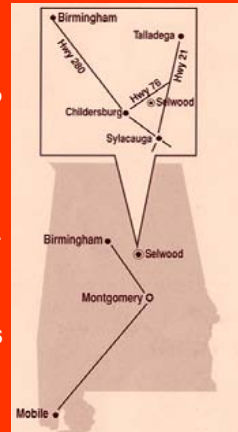

## Directions to Selwood Farm

Selwood Farm is located on Highway 76 between Childersburg and Winterboro in Talladega County, Alabama. The farm is 45 minutes from Birmingham and Anniston, and 90 minutes from Montgomery.

From Birmingham on Highway 280, go East to Childersburg, turn left on Highway 76, following signs to DeSoto Caverns. Go 6 miles to Selwood Farm sign. Turn right.



Go 1/2 mile to gravel drive on the right. Follow driveway to parking.

From Montgomery, Follow 231 thru Wetumpka to Sylacauga. Go under 280 make left turn onto 280, go ten miles. Make a right turn onto AL HWY 76 once you enter Childersburg. Travel 6 miles to Selwood Farm on the right.

## What is Children First Foundation?

Children First Foundation, Inc. (CFF) is a 501c4 non-partisan organization dedicated to improving the lives of Alabama's children by affecting change at the legislative level. Through CFF's hard work the Children First Trust Fund (CFTF) was established in 1999. This fund comes from the tobacco settlement dollars Alabama receives annually and up to 70 million dollars is eligible for appropriation to twelve state agencies. Each year, CFF lobbies the legislature to make sure the CFTF appropriation goes to those state agencies for new and innovative programs for children and families. *It is important to note that our Foundation does not receive any of the Children First Trust Fund.* Our founders felt it was important that all money go directly to programs that would help the children of this state. In addition to securing the Children First Trust Fund, we also work to identify and draft other pieces of legislation that advocate for vital changes needed for the children of Alabama.
